### Take a picture

Select the «shutter» button once to enter the still image action menu. Press the «shutter» button again to take a picture.



### Record a video

Select the «record» button once to enter the video action menu. Press the «record» button again to start a video recording. Hit the button a third time to end the video recording.



### Enable image stabilization

Press the «mode» button and set the image stabilization to «On». Select «OK» to save the setting.



### Change light sensitivity

Press the «mode» button and under light sensitivity select between «Day», «Normal» and «Night» mode. Select «OK» to save the setting.



## Change quality settings

Select «setup» > «settings» > «video settings» to change image and video quality settings. Select «OK» to save.



# WIDRIVE 2

Transfer media files wirelessly to any USB storage device...

### Instructions: Device:

Connect power and press the power button. WiDRIVE 2

2 Insert any USB storage device in the USB port. WiDRIVE 2

3 Select «Sync» and then select «WiDRIVE». EX4000

4 Select «Sync» to start transferring media files. EX4000

When the transfer is complete, take the USB storage device out of the WiDRIVE 2 and connect it to your PC.
The media files are located on the root level.

#### Note:

- Remember to move/copy the media files from your USB storage device between each sync. If not, the next sync can overwrite your files without notice.
- Syncing on the move? The WiDRIVE 2 is capable of running on its internal battery for 5 hours.
- You can also transfer media files directly to a shared folder on your pc (requires admin privileges).
